

HOW A RESOLUTION COMES TO GUIDE MAFP POLICY/RESOURCES

1. RESOLUTION SUBMITTED

One/more members submit a resolution via the MAFP online form.



2. MEMBERS COMMENT

Members may provide comments on resolutions during the open comment period (online), which are then shared with the Reference Committee.



4. RESOLUTION INTRODUCED

Resolutions are introduced at the Resolution Forum, and the Reference Committee shares their recommendations for action.



5. TESTIMONY HEARD

Member testimony is heard at the Resolution Forum in support or opposition of resolutions and recommended actions.



7. RESOLUTION ADOPTED

If a resolution is adopted, it will help guide the time, energy and resources of MAFP staff and leaders.



8. WORK REVIEWED

Work on resolutions is regularly reviewed by MAFP staff and updates are shared with MAFP leaders.



3. RESOLUTION REVIEWED

The Reference Committee reviews resolutions and comments and prepares recommendations for action.



6. MEMBERS DECIDE

Members may vote (in person or online) during the Resolution Forum on what actions to take: adopt, not adopt, refer to the board, file for information.



9. PROGRESS PRESENTED

Progress and outcomes regarding resolutions are made available for members annually via the Resolution Forum.
